

## **Touring the Civil Rights Trail**

The Meridian Civil Rights Trail begins downtown at the African-American Business District. At each marker, a QR code provides access via a smartphone app to a short video about that location. The first seven markers stand within blocks of each other and can easily be toured on foot. After that, you will need a vehicle; directions in this brochure are optimized for driving. Allow at least two hours for the entire tour.
